

Ginninderra Village Markets: Booking form and Stallholder Information

General Information:

- ◆ The markets are held on the 2nd Sunday of each month at Ginninderra Village, O'Hanlon Place, Nicholls.
- ◆ Most stalls are outside. There are a few indoor sites. Indoor sites are allocated on a needs basis, such as older stallholders or items that damage very easily in rain.
- ◆ All stalls are on a first come first served basic. The quicker you book, the quicker you will be allocated a stall space. Your booking form must be accompanied by your rental, payment for the first market. (see attached)
- ◆ Stall rent is \$25 outside and \$30 inside. For the first three markets, \$5 will be deducted from the rent. (A stall space is considered one trestle table. However, outdoor stalls are able to take up more space as the gardens are large and accommodating.) There is a small charge if you require power: \$5 per stall. You must supply your own 15 metre cable and it must have a current electricians tag.
- ◆ You will be able to erect a 3 x 3 metre gazebo outside in the gardens. You must supply this yourself.
- ◆ You'll need to bring your own tables. In time, as the market grows, we may purchase a small range of tables.
- ◆ All stallholders will be allocated 50 market leaflets to distribute in their area, upon booking your stall and this will continue each month. You can request more.
- ◆ Access to set up the market will be from 8.30am. Most stalls will not need to drive in—the markets are close to the car park. However, very heavy items can be driven in through the rear car park. There will be someone on hand to direct you from 8.30am. There is ample, free parking and all cars must be parked outside the Village by 9.30am.
- ◆ Ginninderra Village begins trading at 10am, so stalls should be erected and largely unpacked by that time.
- ◆ Ginninderra Village ceases trading at 5pm. Stalls can stay until that time, but the market is advertised as 10am-4pm so please feel free to start packing at 4pm. You will be able to drive into the village after 5pm to load heavy goods.
- ◆ The Ginninderra Village area is close to Federation Square. We will be providing free tea and instant coffee for stallholders and there'll be an excellent coffee stall. There are a number of cafes in the area, and there will be facilities for heating food you bring yourself in the microwave.
